#### **Geographical scope**

 8 countries (Cameroon, Central African Republic, Congo, Ghana, Liberia, Guyana, Honduras and Vietnam)



**Duration:** 5 years (2021-2025)



#### Programme's objectives

- **General**: Contribution to sustainable forest management
- **Specific**: operationnalisation of the VPA, capacity building of civil society organisations, and support to the private sector in the implementation of the VPA




#### **Programme content – 3 components**

- Component 1 Institutional support for the implementation of VPAs
- Component 2 Stakeholder support (Civil society and private sector)
- Component 3 Coordination, monitoring, and evaluation

















## 4 pilot projects to shape the full intervention (225 kEUR)

Project 1 - "Assessment of the current business model of Forest Sector Operators (FSOs) operating on small and large concessions, and Amerindian communities "

<u>EU FLEGT VPA Programme Component</u>: **Component 2** Stakeholder support focusing on NGOs, communities, and the private sector

<u>Objectives:</u> literature review, interviews, field visits to produce an operational and strategic overview of the current cost structure for FSOs to comply with the Code of Practice of forest operations and VPAs requirements)

Budget: 60 000 EUR

### Project 2 - "Development of the EU-Guyana VPA impact monitoring framework"

<u>EU FLEGT VPA Programme Component</u>: **Component 2** Stakeholder support focusing on NGOs, communities, and the private sector

Objectives: Development, in close collaboration with JMRC and through extensive stakeholder's consultation, of an impact-monitoring framework tailored to the Guyanese context and an operational strategy (finance, capacity, technical support) for its implementation

Budget: 100 000 EUR







## 4 pilot projects to shape the full intervention (225 kEUR)

# Project 3 - "Assessment of the capacity building, and of the quality upgrade and value adding to forest products"

<u>EU FLEGT VPA Programme Component</u>: **Component 2** Stakeholder support focusing on NGOs, communities, and the private sector <u>Objectives</u>: Conduct a study (field, literature, interviews) on 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> transformation of the Guyanese timber supply chain (wood processing plants, exporters/traders) to identify barriers to its development, new potential areas of market growth and a capacity building programme for timber processors to improve its recovery rate and final product quality.

Budget: 25 000 EUR

## Project 4-"IT Consultancy for the design, setting up and rolling out of the IT system of the TLAS"

<u>EU FLEGT VPA Programme Component</u>: **Component 1** Institutional support covering the actions necessary for development and implementation of the TLAS.

Objectives: Define a technical and operational roadmap to set up and roll out Guyanese TLAS IT System, encompassing the Wood Tracking System (WTS) and the Wood Legality System in compliance with the VPA. Two main expected deliverables:

- o ToRs for the content of a WTS compliant with TLAS IT Systems requirements
- Configuration of an assistance Program that will set up the WTS, through i) a WTS IT project development to develop the system and ii) a
  Building-capacity project to deploy the WTS on the ground.

Budget: 40 000 EUR 6
