The Guyana Forestry Commission (GFC) will be having an upcoming engagement to form the National Standard Setting Working Group (NSSWG) for Guyana's national forest and wood products certification system.

The NSSWG will develop the standard and the associated procedures that will be the basis for the national certification system.

The GFC has committed to completing the national certification system by the end of 2021 to be available for international assessment and endorsement by the Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification systems (PEFC) sometime in 2022.

We expect to finalise the composition of the NSSWG at this meeting on April 30, 2021, and encourage you to send us suggested candidates for this Working Group **by close of business on Friday, April 30, 2021.
